Robert J. Binns, 79, a longtime resident of Stoughton, died at the Kindred Hospital in Stoughton on Sunday, April 4. He was the devoted husband of the late Ladora A. (Cruickshank) Binns. Born and raised in Boston, he was a graduate of Roxbury Memorial High School. He was a resident of Stoughton since 1965. Mr. Binns was an auto body shop manager at Owen Motors in Dedham and Rodman Ford in Foxboro in the 1980's before retiring in the 1990's. A licensed appraiser, he also worked for Delaney Chevy, Randolph Chrysler Plymouth, Liberty Mutual and Commercial Union.
