**D**aniel J. Herlihy, 67, a longtime resident of Stoughton, died unexpectedly on Thursday, March 4 at Brigham & Women's Hospital in Boston. He was the husband of Carol A. (LaFrance) Herlihy. Born and raised in Somerville, he was a graduate of St. Mary's High School in Cambridge, Class of 1960 and Stonehill College in Easton, Class of 1965. He was a resident of Stoughton since 1972. Mr. Herlihy worked at Avon High School for 35 years, first as a teacher and towards the end of his career as Principal before retiring in 2001. He also coached both basketball and baseball at Avon High School for most of his career. He then taught at Brockton High School in the Math Department until 2008. He also taught at the Old Colony YMCA in Brockton for the past 2 years. Mr. Herlihy was a lifetime member of the Massachusetts Teachers Association and the National Education Association. He was also a member of the Stoughton Historical Society, the Old Colony YMCA and the Irish Cultural Center in Canton. He enjoyed gardening, walking, playing golf and spending time with his family, especially his 4 grandchildren. In addition to his wife, Mr. Herlihy is survived by his children, Corinne M. Herlihy and her partner Sue Seufert of NY, Cristen A. Tabors and her husband Dave of Weston and Daniel W. Herlihy and his wife Clare of MD, as well as his grandchildren, Caitlyn and Jackson Tabors and Cooper and Colby Herlihy.
