**P**anfilo G. “Pat” DelMonico, 86, died at West Acres Nursing Home in Brockton on Sunday, May 31. He was the husband of Mary A. (Picillo) DelMonico. Son of the late Giacinto and Carmela (Traficante) DelMonico, he was born in Roxbury and educated in Boston schools and Roxbury Memorial High School.
