Thomas E. Rogerson, Jr., 77, died at the Caritas Good Samaritan Medical Center in Brockton on Sunday, April 19. He was the husband of Margaret E. (Welch) Rogerson. Son of the late Edward Thomas Rogerson and Catherine (Halibozek) Rogerson, he was born in Roxbury and educated in Boston schools. He was a resident of Jamaica Plain for over 30 years before moving to Stoughton in 1994. Mr. Rogerson was a Sergeant in the U.S. Marine Corps and a veteran of the Korean Conflict. He was a grocery clerk at Stop & Shop for 42 years before retiring in 1996. He was a member of the VFW Post 722 in Jamaica Plain.
