Paul L. Morris, 89, died Friday, September 12, at the Caritas Good Samaritan Medical Center in Brockton. He was the husband of Celia L. (Lazdin) Morris. He also served in the Korean Conflict retiring from the U.S. Air Force as a Captain in 1961. Mr. Morris went to work for EG&G in Bedford as a Production Control Engineer. In his free time he enjoyed golfing at Ponkapoag with friends and colleagues. He was also an active outdoorsman who enjoyed hunting, fishing and all outdoor activities.
