**P**hilip A. Cave, 65, died at home in Stoughton on Tuesday, June 5 after a brief illness. He was the loving husband of Beverly A. (Phillips) Cave. Born in Great Yeldham Essex, England, he was a longtime resident of Stoughton. Mr. Cave was a graduate of St. Mary's School in Stoughton and Newman Preparatory School in Boston. He was a U.S. Army National Guard Veteran of the Vietnam Era. Mr. Cave was the owner of Imperial Fence in Stoughton for many years.
