**E**rnest A. Coletti, 80, died on Friday, March 31 in Clearwater, FL after a period of failing health. He was the husband of 53 years of Barbara (Stacey) Coletti. Born and educated in Brighton, Mr. Coletti was a resident of Stoughton for over 20 years before moving to Clearwater, FL 16 years ago. He was a WW II Veteran of the US Army. Mr. Coletti was the owner of Baker St. Deli in West Roxbury for over 10 years, retiring at age 62. Prior to that, he worked as a Laborer for Local 22 in Boston for 30 years, retiring in 1976 at which time he bought the Baker St. Deli.
