Thomas M. Chestnut, 84, died at the Jordan Hospital in Plymouth on Sunday, February 12 after a period of failing health. He was the husband of the late Winnifred M. (White) Chestnut. Born in Stoughton he was a graduate of Stoughton High School, Class of 1941. Mr. Chestnut was an U.S. Army Veteran of World War II. He was a supervisor at JW Wood in Stoughton and then Johnson & Johnson in Georgia for many years before retiring 22 years ago. He lived in Stoughton for over 40 years before moving to Carver after his retirement. Mr. Chestnut was a past President of Stoughton Historical Society. In his free time he enjoyed woodworking, cooking, traveling and collecting antiques. Mr. Chestnut is survived by his cousin, William Chestnut of Stoughton.
