George Calvin Lantz of Stoughton, MA, formerly of Randolph, Brockton and Hyde Park, went to be with the Lord Jesus Christ on February 8, 2006 at 72 years young. Educated in Hyde Park, George served on the front lines in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict. As an educator, he taught graphic arts & managed the bus program at the Martin Luther King Jr. Middle School in Dorchester before retiring. He is fondly remembered for his humor, wit and insight by thousands of Boston area students. Mr. Lantz was the loving son of the late Ernest Lantz & Georgia (Nogler) Lantz of Hyde Park and late brother Fred Lantz of Brockton.
