Service held at Clairemont Mortuary on Sept. 29th from 9am – 1pm. Burial to follow at Miramar National Cemetery at 2:15pm



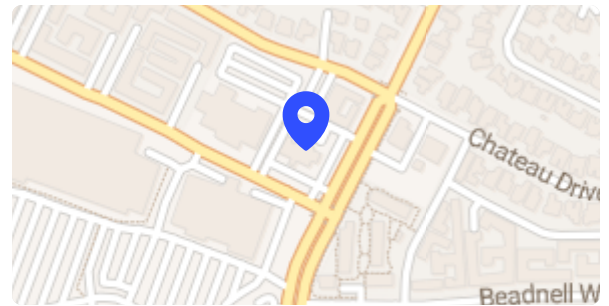
