Together, they built a legacy of love that continues through their daughter Barbara and her husband Robert, sons Joseph with Melody, and Ricky with Wendy, along with seven grandchildren, sixteen great-grandchildren, and her brother John Kolb.

A devout Catholic, Erlene's faith was the cornerstone of her existence. She was a woman of immense strength, kindness, and generosity. Her favorite melodies of country western music would fill the room, as would the warmth of her presence.

May she rest in peace and her memory be a blessing to all who knew her.






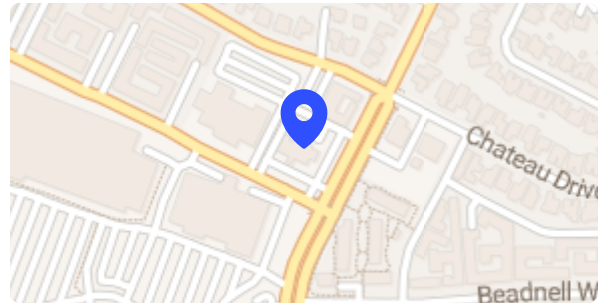
